### PASTOR’S MESSAGE

God spoke through the Apostle John and tells us to, “love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God” (1 John 4:7). One of the biggest errors I have seen in the “Christian Community” is that we misunderstand and misapply what it is to “love one another.” Loving someone is not telling them what they want to hear. Loving someone isn’t validating and affirming sin in their lives because we don’t want to judge. Loving someone isn’t turning a blind eye to rebellion, that is leading them to an eternity apart from God, because we don’t want to offend. No, to truly “love one another” is to speak the truth even if it means we will be rejected and hated by those to whom we are speaking.

The truth has never been a part of “Pop Culture.” So, when you see high profile Christians endorsing the trendy narrative of the day, most likely, they are not standing on the side of truth. I must be honest, I am more concerned for the state of Christianity today than ever before. Many of the Christian leaders that I look up to have bowed the knee (literally) to the ideology of the day. My heart has been heavy as I have watched them cater to the culture rather than speak truth into that culture.

As Christ followers, we are called to stand on the truth of Jesus, point people to Jesus, point people to repentance, point people to the truth because that is what it is to truly “love one another.” Jesus told us beforehand that the world is going to hate us because we are telling them what they need to hear (John 15:18). Jesus told us that those in darkness do not want the light because it will expose their wickedness (John 3:20). Please, do not take the easy road. Please, do not cater to the culture because that is the path of least resistance. People will die and spend eternity apart from God because we are too afraid to stand up for the truth.

The world is so very lost and so very dark. Christian, you have what they need. You have the Good News that can regenerate their lives, transform them from the inside out, and make them new creations in Jesus Christ. Don’t be angry or bitter with lost people, THEY ARE LOST! Be angry with ourselves if we are not pointing them to the only ONE who can rescue them. You have the truth, will you “love one another” enough to speak that truth?
